BE&K Building Group Awarded Construction of New Self-Storage Facility in Temple Hills, Maryland

The BE&K Building Group has been selected to provide construction management at risk services for Beech Road Self Storage Facility in Temple Hills, Maryland. The project located about 10 miles southeast of Washington, D.C. The owner is SJM Partners. The projected budget for the 110,000-square-foot facility is \$4.5 million.

The facility's 1,000 storage units will be protected by a sophisticated security system package that includes wireless alarm systems and video surveillance. The structural design incorporates load-bearing metal studs supporting several metal decks.



The architect is Butz • Wilbern of Mclean, Virginia. The estimated construction start date is September 2009.
