BE&K Building Group Awarded a Second Self-Storage Project in Maryland by Owner, SJM Partners

The BE&K Building Group has been awarded a second self-storage project by SJM Partners. Our Washington office will be constructing the Old Alexandria Ferry Storage Facility in Clinton, Maryland, located about 20 miles southeast of Washington, D.C. The

projected budget for this construction management at risk assignment is \$1.5 million.



The Old Alexandria Ferry Storage project

consists of four single-story facilities, totaling 44,600 square feet. Each of the four buildings will be protected with wireless alarm systems and video surveillance. Our team will integrate the security, electrical and fire alarm systems with those already in place for neighboring pre-existing facilities.

The architect is Butz • Wilbern of Mclean, Virginia. Construction is expected to start in September 2009. Just last month, SJM Partners selected the BE&K Building Group to construct its Beech Road Self Storage Facility in nearby Temple Hills, Maryland, for an estimated \$4.5 million.
